Visiting Committees' Reports

Mr Lynch, said that in the course of his visits of inspection he had found that the Art side of the school was glaringly exposed, but he also found that we appeared to be training art students for the purpose of leaving Ballarat. He understood that 75% of the present art teachers in Victoria had received their training at the school and conversations with instructors in the Art School had disclosed the fact that we were unable to keep our students long enough.

On the Engineering side the position appeared to be quite the reverse. These students were either in local employment or were training for the purpose of entering some local workshop.

He suggested that it might be better if we encouraged students to take courses of tuition which would fit them for employment in local mills rather than in the higher branches of Art such as teaching and commercial art.

In the general discussion that ensued the President and Councillors expressed the view that it was to be regretted that Ballarat could not employ all of our Art students but that could not be regarded as sufficient grounds for us to refuse to train them in the higher branches of Art.

The President said that the Council appreciated and welcomed such reports which showed a keen interest on the part of the visiting committee.
