Annual Report & Statement of Receipts & Expenditure

The Annual Report and Financial Statement.
The President in moving the adoption of the Annual Report and Financial Statement said that it disclosed a very satisfactory state of affairs. A greater interest in technical education was being displayed today and he thought that the large increase in numbers of students at our school could be attributed to the propaganda brought about through advertising our scholarships. We in common with most schools in the State were experiencing great difficulty in providing adequate accommodation and equipment.

Mr Lederman in seconding the adoption, said that the school was very fortunate in its staff. The Principal, Art Principal, Registrar and the whole of the staff were most conscientious and enthusiastic. The successes of the art school students in competitions were most gratifying. He felt confident that technical education would receive much help from Mr Elham as a result of his trip abroad. Speaking of buildings and equipment he said that the present year would prove a most difficult one with the large enrollments and the lack of equipment and accommodation.

The President, before putting the motion, said that we were very fortunate in our staff by reason of being a Council controlled school. We could pick our own staff, then keep them. The motion was then put and carried.
