After a discussion on the most suitable day it was agreed that with the exception of Wingham on Thursday afternoon at 3 p.m. would be the most suitable time for a day class. Mr. Dummer undertook to try and arrange for his students to accept of Thursday afternoons also. The President suggested that one session on Thursday afternoons, commencing at 3 p.m., and another on Saturday morning be substituted for the evening classes at present being held was adopted as a satisfactory solution of the problem if the Education Department would give its consent to the alteration in State school periods that would be necessary. The President said that the school council would now take up the matter with the Department on these lines.

This concluded the business and the meeting closed.
