Business out of correspondence

It was unanimously resolved that the following two resolutions be and are hereby confirmed:

1. That the representatives of the five Council-controlled Schools present at this meeting are unanimously of opinion that it would be detrimental to the interests of Technical Education and to the welfare of the schools concerned, and to the staffs and students connected therewith, if the present powers of appointment and control vested in the Councils were curtailed; "if" in the opinion of this Conference it is desirable that on any question arising affecting the five Senior Schools herein represented, the question concerned should be considered by a Conference of the Principals of the schools with a view to having a recommendation made to the respective Councils with a view to joint action."
