On the recommendation of the Finance Committee it was resolved that the following resolutions be and are hereby approved, and that they be submitted to the Premier and the Minister of Public Instruction by means of a deputation of Presidents of the five Council-controlled Schools including Technical Colleges.

1. That the Councils of the above schools are strongly opposed to the decision of Cabinet to retire members of the Teaching Staffs on the 65th anniversary of their birth. Council comments, in the case of these five schools, that discretion be used in

each Council to retire each individual member of their staff either on the 65th anniversary of birth or on the 31st December following that birth-day, as considered by the Council in each case to be in the best interests of the school.

2. That the Councils of the above-mentioned schools request the honorable the Minister of Public Instruction to grant a discretion to each Council to expend on any one item of equipment a sum in excess of £25.
