14th December, 1940, at 10-30 a.m. for the
purpose of interviewing Mr. A. E. Lambert.

Mr. D. Maxwell and the Principal, Mr. A. J.
Herseltine.

After Mr. Lambert had been introduced to
the members of the Committee the President
outlined the duties ~~of the~~ pertaining to the
position, hours, subjects, holidays and
requirements under the Superannuation Act.

Mr. Lambert answered several questions
by members of the Committee regarding his
practical experience in Western Australia
and said that he was willing to give
an assurance to remain in the position
for at least two years if he should be
appointed.

Mr. Lambert was then asked to retire while
the Committee went into conference.

After a brief discussion, during which it
was apparent that the Committee was
unanimous regarding the appointment
of Mr. Lambert, it was resolved that
Mr. Austin E. Lambert be appointed
to the position of Senior Instructor - Mechanical
Engineering at a commencing salary of
£528 per annum and that the Principal
contact the Education Department with a

view to having the appointment approved by
the Selection Board of the Education Department
and confirmed by the Minister as soon
as possible (Mrs Farr & Martin)
