It is advisable for us to prepare data on accommodation and facilities required at present for submission to the Chief Architect when he pays a visit to the school in the near future.

He also thought that any courses which might be undertaken in the future should be taken into consideration in arriving at an estimate of requirements. He also thought that enrolment and population figures for the past 25 years would be very helpful.

Mr. Rederman said he thought that information on the lines suggested by Mr. Farr would cover requirements for the present. The position in regard to the area available for new buildings was indefinite as ^{also} was the obtaining of an option on any freehold property in the vicinity.

Mr. John said that the more he thought about the matter the more he was convinced that our best policy would be to concentrate on building on the present site. He was afraid that the acquisition of additional areas and buildings would result in the school being saddled with more unsuitable classrooms and workshops of which we had more than sufficient now.

Mr. Beauland supported Mr. John's remarks. After a further general discussion on the information required to enable estimates of accommodation required to be arrived at
