Plans of New Buildings

The President reported that the Principal
had contacted the Chief Architect
regarding the plan which had been
approved by the Commonwealth and
had been informed that it was
the plan of the workshops and
engineering laboratories on the north-
eastern corner and not the plan
suggested when the long-range plan
was forwarded to the Department in
May last. The President said
that he had then contacted the
Minister, who knew nothing about it.

However, the Minister had since
contacted him by telephone and
had informed him that the Acting
Chief Inspector had assured him
that to proceed with this plan would
not be to the detriment of the
long-range plan. He (the President)
had arranged a conference between

the Minister, C. S. A. Farr and himself for
the following day (24th August) and felt it
was desirable for the Finance Committee
to arrive at a decision regarding the
matter.

It was resolved that the plans
approved by the Commonwealth be
proceeded with but that it be
stressed that the Court House be
altered to accommodate school
classes, having in mind the additional
classes which will be needed for
reconstruction training.
