In reply to a question as to his classification the Registrar said that his annual salary was £488 plus the cost of living allowance, at present £30 per annum. Trade Instructors received £459 per annum, Senior Assistants £531 and Heads of Departments £591 per annum plus the cost of living allowance.

It was then resolved that it be recommended to the Council that steps be taken by the President, the Hon. Treasurer and the Principal to obtain an improvement in the classification of the position of Registrar. (Ces. Farr & Beartland).
