The Principal said that at present the Junior Technical School was using certain rooms in the Art School and causing overcrowding there. This could be lessened by transferring Engineering Drawing to a new place such as a top or second floor on the building at present under construction.

In the discussion that followed it was agreed that the obvious course to be adopted by the Public Works Department would be the provision of a second floor on the workshops at present under construction and for that reason it was considered advisable to press for a new building on the old Court House site thereby conforming to the Master Plan.

It was resolved that the Minister of Public Instruction be contacted and be asked to approve of the erection of the Engineering unit on the old Court House site as shown on the Master Plan submitted last year. (Mrs Lederman & Farr).
