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in a temporary capacity was carried and it, together with the other resolutions, would be forwarded to the incoming Chairman.

Mr. Lederman said that the President had handled the Conference in a very capable manner and had been paid the compliment of being elected for a second term. This was very unusual and he desired to move that the Council compliment the President on the honor conferred on him.

Seconded by Mr. Wilson and carried unanimously.

Installation of Boiler.

Mr. B. A. John said that the boiler made by his firm for the school was now being installed under the direction of the Public Works Department. He desired it to be placed on record that his firm did not approve of the manner in which the installation was being carried out, particularly in reference to the chimney stack, ^{foundations} piping and blow-off cocks. Protests had been made to the Engineer of the Public Works Department but were of no avail. It appeared that architectural considerations had been allowed to predominate over recognized engineering practice.

Youth Centre.

Mr. A. W. Nicholson reported that the

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matter of increasing the membership of the Youth Centre was at present under consideration and he would like a direction from the Council regarding such increase.

It was decided to leave the matter to Mr. Nicholson's discretion.

Visiting Committee

Mrs. Nicholson and Mr. B. John were appointed the Visiting Committee for the ensuing month, Mr. Nicholson to act as Convenor.

Attend Meeting of Council

It was decided that owing to the commencement of the vacation on the 21st December the next meeting of the Council be held on the 12th instead of the 19th December.

This concluded the business and the meeting closed.
