Visiting Committee's Report.

Gs Wilson and Small reported on their visit to the Junior Technical School

Dressmaking Department and Woolclassing on the 10th May.

In the Junior Technical School a partition requires shifting to provide additional room for modelling. The old linotype machine should also be removed as it is only taking up valuable space.

In the yard, a concrete square is broken and uneven. A new square is desirable. The steps near the boiler house are in need of repair and a space between the garden and the school also requires alteration. The Albert Street gate is also in bad condition and should be replaced with a cyclope gate. The grounds below the school building were also very uneven and required levelling.

In the Dressmaking Department they found work progressing in an efficient manner. There were 25 students in that particular class and 150 students on the roll. They noticed that some of the tables were warped and uneven
