Business To interview Mr. A. A. Robertson.

After answering various questions concerning his previous experience, particularly during the years 1939-1944, Mr. Robertson said that if he were selected he would ask to be appointed at the maximum salary of £815 plus £30 cost of living allowance. He would also need to find a house, either to rent or to purchase, within a period of say three months after taking up duties. As regards transport expenses of his family and effects the cost would be approximately £150 and he felt that as other staffs reimbursed these expenses Victoria ought to be prepared to do likewise.

Mr. Robertson then retired while the matter was discussed.

It was unanimously agreed that Mr. Robertson be offered the position of Principal of the school on the conditions outlined subject to the approval of the Education Department on a recommendation from the School
