

21-8-46 and in his opinion that difficulty could be solved satisfactorily. The question of removal expenses could be taken up with the Education Department but an alternative solution was possible as Mr. Robertson had offered to present his valuable technical library to the school. Arrangements could be made to purchase this library - the cost to be spread over an agreed period of time and to be regarded as being in lieu of removal expenses. The matter of a suitable house could not be tackled until Mr. Robertson took up duty but the Finance Committee felt that this difficulty could then be solved by members of the Council taking a personal interest in it.

Ces Lederman and Farr endorsed the President's remarks and said that Mr. Robertson impressed all members of the Committee by his mental activity, drive and pleasing personality.

His qualifications were outstanding and he was the only candidate who possessed all the qualifications required.

It was resolved that Mr. Robertson be recommended to the Education Department for appointment as Principal at the maximum salary and that he be reimbursed the cost of removal expenses from Roberts to Ballarat. (Ces Lederman & Farr)
