Seven applications were received for

position.

After considering the applications
it was decided to place Mr Ramm

number two and to endeavour to
arrange for Mr Ramm to come to
Ballarat for interview on Saturday,
21 December.

Red Cross Hut.

Mr Richards reported that the Chief
Executive Officer of the Red Cross had
visited Ballarat on the 17th inst.

An inspection of the large
rehabilitation hut was made and
it was found that two wings of
this hut and the administrative
section were available. Contact
had been made with the Education
Department and the Minister had
agreed to the school making an
offer not exceeding £200 for the
sections available subject to
a valuation being made by the
local Public Works Inspector.

It was resolved that the
negotiations be continued and
that a letter expressing the
Council's thanks be forwarded
to Mr. G. G. Rogers local Chairman
of the local Red Cross Society
(Bredberman & M. B. Ptn.)
