Since then Mr. Ramm had been consulted and he was strongly in favour of the move. Mr. Richards then produced plans of the Court House showing how the various branches of the Electrical Dept. would be accommodated.

An inspection of the present Electrical Laboratory and Basement and the Old Court House was then made by the Committee.

It was resolved that it be a recommendation to the School Council that the transfer of the Electrical Department to the old Court House as soon as it is vacated by the Carpentry classes be approved.
