It was resolved that this matter

Cleaning and caretaking of Museum
The Registrar reported that as the
result of an amendment to the
Cleaners Award Mr. R. Rowlands
would have to be paid for 40 1/2 hours
in respect of the 35 hours worked by
him as cleaner of the Art School
and Assay Laboratory. The other
9 hours were worked by him in the
Museum for which he received £75 per
annum from the City Council through
the War Museum Committee.

The Acting Principal said that the
work of cleaning the Art School and
Assay Laboratory called for a full
time cleaner and in his opinion
it would be better for the School to
employ Mr. Rowlands for 44 hours
per week to attend to those duties.
