Business Application by City Council for portion of land at corner of Lydiard and Grant Streets. After inspecting this triangular block it was decided to recommend to the School Council that no opposition be offered to the granting to the City Council of an area commencing at a point 30 ft east of the present corner and linked by a curved line to point in a similar position in Grant Street, thereby giving a rounded end to the property retained for building purposes.
