(b) Trade Students.

John Prizes for employees of that firm and two to be known as the Ronaldson & Tiffith Prizes for employees of that firm will be awarded. - Assaying samples for Gold, Silver, Lead, Copper or other commercial constituents - Per estimation £1-1-0

Assaying fertilisers for Phosphoric Acid or other commercial constituents - Per estimation £1-1-0

Assaying bullion for Gold or Silver 15/-

Partial quantitative analysis of Gres, Minerals etc. from £2-2-0 to £4-4-0.

Time limit on Diplomas

On the recommendation of the Board of Studies the following provisions regarding the award of Diplomas were adopted:-

1. Any Diploma Course should be normally completed by full day students within a period of eight years from the date of commencement of course.

2. If such course be not completed within this period the applicant must submit special reasons to the Board of Studies as to why the course was not completed within the given period. The Board is empowered to accept or reject this application.
