Business To interview Mr. R. Bainwaring, an applicant for the position of Head of the Art School.

Before inviting Mr. Bainwaring in for interview the President outlined the qualifications of the four applicants with service qualifications - Messrs. Kellock, Bainwaring, Bruce-Bayne and Shelton, and said that the two last mentioned applicants would be at the school for interview at 9-30 am on Saturday, 30th April.

Mr. Bainwaring was then invited in. He had with him a large number of photographs of paintings executed by him as Official War Artist during the South Pacific campaign and now in the War Museum at Lambessa.

He answered several questions as to his secondary and art education and said that he was favourably impressed by the set-up in the Art School. He also gave an assurance that if appointed he would accept the position without reservation.

The President informed him that two other applicants were to be interviewed
