Business Interview Mr. R. J. Bruce - Bayne and Mr.

Head of the Art School.

Mr. Bayne was interviewed first and in
answer to questions stated that the
positions he had held were all short time
ones. He had studied Medicine during
the past three years but had failed at
the final examinations. Although he
obtained his Architecture Degree in 1926
he had never practised. He did not
bring any samples of his work but
stated that he intended taking up
portrait painting again in the near
future.

Mr. Pheloung was then interviewed and
stated that he completed his final
examinations with Honours at East
Sydney Technical College in 1948.

He had done a considerable amount of
work for commercial art firms and
produced several samples of his work
for inspection.
