Mr Overell did so and was confident that the top floor could be made suitable by improving the present lighting and ventilation, sheeting the roof beams and by using the exterior stairway.

The Principal reported that Mr Shannon had telephoned him during the day and said that he was drawing up a list of requirements to submit to Mr Overell. He requested that no action be taken until further advice is received from the Department. Such a move would entail the removal of the top floor collection of exhibits to another location and the equipment for the classes would be a charge against the school's equipment grant.

The chairman said that these developments had all taken place so quickly that no time was available in which to call meetings.

It was resolved that the actions of Vice President C. A. Farr and the Principal in this matter be endorsed and that the proposition be recommended to the School Council for adoption.
