they had inspected the Junior Technical
School and the Pottery Department
on Tuesday, 13th May.

Mr H. B. Garner accompanied them on

lockers were much appreciated.
They noticed several hot-holes in
the assembly area and Mr Garner
had suggested the painting of a
galvanised iron fence on the south
side. The ramp leading to the
hay area was very slippery and
had resulted in several minor
accidents during wet weather.

The gardens were in course of
preparation for planting later.
