

17-9-52. He also felt that pressure should be brought to bear on the Government to provide adequate educational facilities for children now in primary schools. A survey he was now completing showed that in 1956 there would be a large number of children for whom no accommodation in post-primary schools would be available unless prompt action was taken by the Government.

He would suggest the calling of a meeting of local educationalists with a view to demanding provision for these children.

As the hour was late it was resolved that this matter be made an order of the day for the next meeting. (Mrs Hawry & Stoker)

This concluded the business and the meeting closed.
