Finance Committee Special Meeting

Held in the Principal's Office on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> August 1953 at 10-30 a.m.

Present The President Mr E. J. Liffitt (Chair)  
Vice-Presidents Mrs M. S. Scanland and Mr B. John, The Hon. Treasurer, Mr G. B. Lavery, Mrs Linaker and Webb, The Principal, Mr A. W. Richards

Business The President said that as the result of an unsigned & seditious notice attacking Mr B. Fairbank, Lecturer in English, and student members of the Magazine Committee an investigation and interrogation had been conducted by the Discipline Committee consisting of the Principal and Messrs Jaallop, G. J. Hillman and H. Jacey. This notice, covering two pages of foolscap, had been posted on the notice board during the week and had been read by a large number of staff and students. The Discipline Committee had found that five students were concerned in this matter and an examination of hand writing on mid-year examination papers indicated that second-year Diploma student John Collier was responsible for writing the notice.

The President said that he had discussed the matter with the Discipline Committee on the previous Thursday
