Visiting Committee's Report

Mrs Ballou reported that an inspection  
of the old Court House had been  
made by Mr A. W. Lynch and himself  
on Tuesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> August.

In the electrical section they noticed  
that portion of the plaster ceiling had  
fallen as a result of damp caused  
by the leaking roof. They met Mr. Cannon  
in the Refrigeration Department and felt  
that he was doing a good job with the  
equipment he had assembled there.

The Motor Mechanics and Woodcladding  
Departments were not in operation that  
evening but Mr Ballou reported that he  
had paid a subsequent visit to them.  
He noted the extensions to the Motor  
Mechanics building but felt it was  
rather cold and cheerless and would  
be much better if a ceiling were  
installed. This would result in  
much warmer conditions in cold  
weather as the heat from the gas  
thermostat and the fire now  
escaped through the ridge on the roof.  
He also noticed the ancient utility  
and felt that if there was much  
use for it something more modern  
would be more suitable.

The fence from the Court House to  
the corner was showing signs of  
deterioration but a coat of paint  
now would preserve it for a number  
of years.
