Business Training of Boiler Attendants
The Registrar reported that in response
to the Council's request for co-operation
by the F.E.D. & F.A., representatives of
that body waited on him on 27th October
and discussed the matter at some
length.

They produced data to show that they

conducted by four of their members on a
voluntary basis, and practical experience
arranged with local industries.
