

CHESTER AND LOCKES MINE 8022 / 48

Location: Near the Old Walkers Hotel, Upper Yarra catchment area

Description

The mine is located about 300 metres south of the Old Walkers Hotel site (see report) on the Marysville-Woods Point Road. Evidence exists of the old blacksmith's shop, the bull wheel used to carry spoil to the surface, and of the many shafts in the area.

History

A Mr Chester established the mine in 1898 and sunk a 11 metre shaft with offset tunnels. He worked the mine until 1940 and perhaps longer. Mr George Locke, his original partner, had a hut at the Cumberland at some stage prior to 1939.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE:

Recorded in 1989, site consists of remains of a blacksmiths shop, a bell wheel used to carry spoil to the surface from mine shafts, and remains mine shafts.

RESULTS OF REASSESSMENT:

During the Outer Eastern Metro Reassessment Project (Feb 2009) the approximate location of this site was identified; however, the vegetation at this location was extremely overgrown, and therefore too difficult to enter, and considered unsafe with concealed mineral mine shafts.

PLACE HISTORY:

A Mr Chester established the mine in 1898 and worked it until 1940, possibly longer. His partner, Mr George Rocke had a hut at the Cumbernauld zone stage prior to 1939. (Supple et al 1989).

PRESENT USE:

THREATS: Bushland, water catchment area

Bushfire (possible fire of Feb 2009 impacted this site).




