Born in Melbourne in 1936 he grew up on his parents farm in the beautiful Steavenson River Valley near Marysville.

His talent for drawing became evident at an early age and as such his Watercolours were in great demand.

He finished school in 1955 and then worked for a bank and a petroleum company before joining the Australian Public Service.

Painting during his spare time, he joined the Canberra Artist Society and made the transition from Watercolours to Oils, a medium in which he gained a great deal of popularity and success.



As a self-taught artist, he had his first solo exhibition in 1974, which was a complete success.

He moved with his wife to Eildon, and the area provided him with much inspiration for his landscape paintings.

He died on the 25th April 2021 aged 84.
