

The Yellow Dog Day Visitor Area has been totally rebuilt from the ground up, after the 2009 Black Saturday Bushfires devastated the area.

Today it is an excellent Day Visitor Area, that is only five minutes drive or 15 minutes walk from Marysville.

The area is in a small secluded valley, just off the left of Falls Road, 500 metres from the Marysville township boundary. There is ample car parking area, and the proximity to the river makes it a perfect location for those wishing to enjoy the river, without the people.

There are two picnic tables, both with concrete bases, and one is under a large roof. There are no toilets or any other facilities here, though the beauty of the location makes up for this.

Further up the road, is Pfeiffer Falls, a small waterfall on the left of the road, as the road navigates a small valley.

Yellow Dog, was named after a dingo, that

frequented the Marysville area in days past. While it is no longer to be seen, its memory lives on at this Day Visitor Area.

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Travel to Marysville.
- 2. From Marysville, travel along Falls Road for 1.8 kilometres.
- Turn left into Yellow Dog Road and tavel
 1.2 km to the Yellow Dog Day Visitor Area (just before the bridge).

There are no rubbish bins at this location. Please take your rubbish home with you, and recycle it. Fires are permitted in the supplied fireplaces, though are not permitted on days of Total Fire Ban.
