



The Keppel Creek Day Visitor Area and Camping Area were rebuilt, after the 2009 Black Saturday Bushfires devastated the area. They are now an excellent place to camp or visit, and are located just 20 minutes north of Marysville, on the Mount Margaret Road.

The camping area is in a small secluded valley, on the banks of the Keppel Creek, as it the Day Visitor Area. It is well grassed, though this is drier in the summer months.

The camping area is close to the Cathedral State Park, which offers the visitor many beautiful walks and daytime experiences. Refer to our Cathedral Walks brochure for more details on available walks.

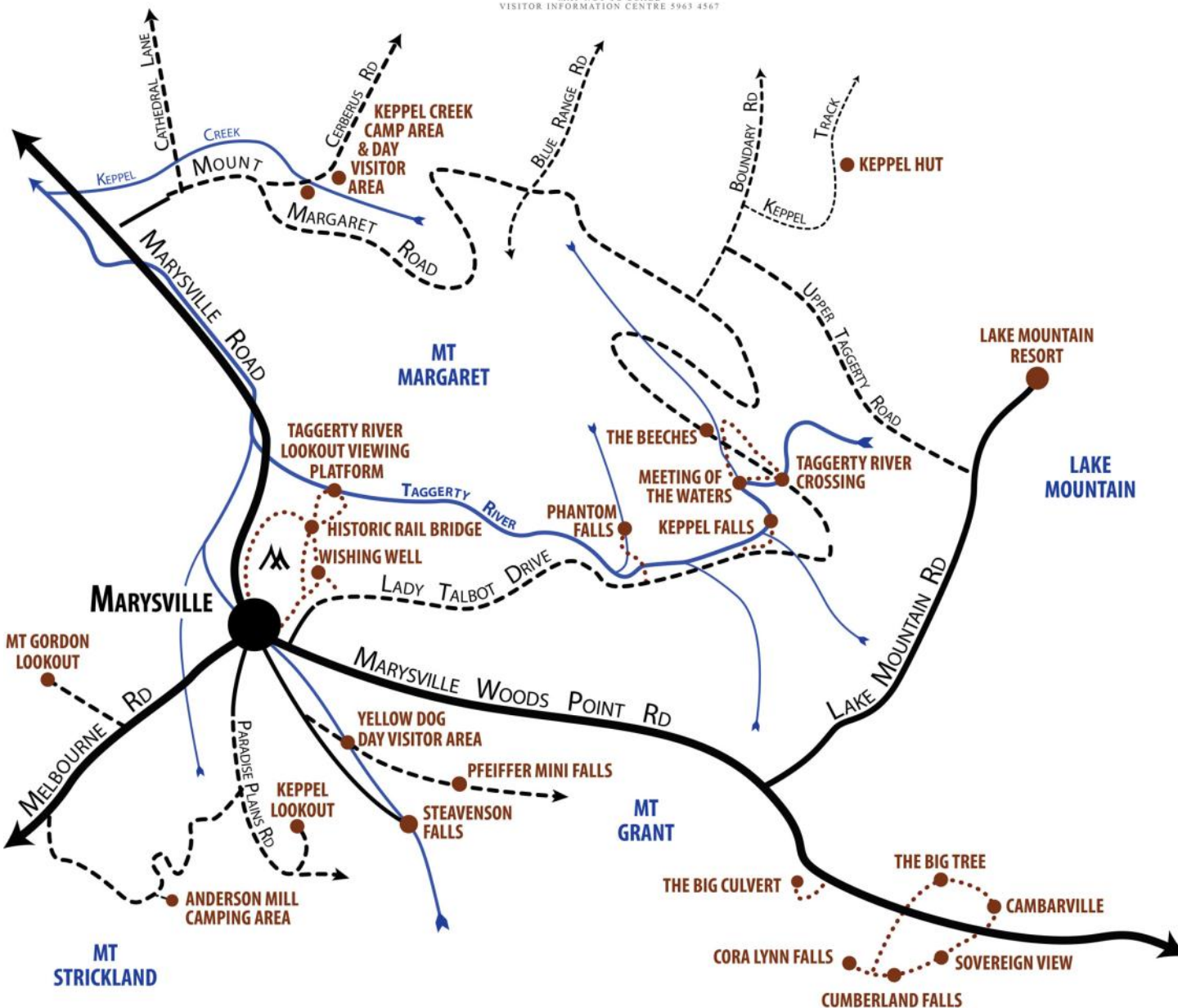

FROM ALEXANDRA

1. Travel to Buxton on the Maroondah Highway.
2. Continue towards Marysville on the Buxton Marysville Road for 3.8 kilometres.
3. Turn left into Mount Margaret Road..
4. Travel for 2.8km to Keppel Creek Day Area and Camp Area.

FROM MARYSVILLE

1. Travel 7.5km north on the Buxton Marysville Road & turn right into Mount Margaret Road.
2. Travel for 2.8km to Keppel Creek Day Area and Camp Area.

There are no rubbish bins at this location. Please take your rubbish home with you, and recycle it.

Fires are permitted in the supplied fireplaces.
No fires are permitted on days of Total Fire Ban.
Ensure camp fires are extinguished before leaving.
