HEAD LICE. One isolated case of head lice has been found

a treatable andppreventable condition, and therefore is not a disaster, but admittedly it is a matter of concern as it is uncomfortable and can lead to scalp sores from scratching. As head lice do spread from person to person especially as children play and work closely together, it would be advisable for families to check their primary and secondary school age children. Signs to look for are: - constant scratching of scalp, small white specks (nits) attached to the hairs near their roots, -- adult lice -- small insects among the hair. Treatment 1. "PARID" shampoo, then repeat shampoo in three days. "Quallada" and other preparations from a chemist are as equally effective. 2. Machine wash or boil pillow cases & sheets. 3. Clean and disinfect
