COMMUNITY CARE CENTRE.

In spite of sleet and some snow, the Annual General Meeting was surprisingly well attended, about 40 people braving the weather. The President Youth, Sport & Recreation. 2. Lion's Club donation Cr.J.Haycraft in his address gave a concise account of £500.00. Monies received from monthly dances. of the year's activities, the highlight being the opening of the new centre by the Minister for Health The Hon. W.H. Houghton M.L.C. on August 19th 1977 and its successful functioning since then. Our first centre car was traded in very advantageously in June of this year and a new Ford Escort is on the road. Our most expensive piece of equipment acquired during the year was the micro-wave machine for deep-heat treatment, said to be much appreciated by the footballers amongst others. Over the year, people have been assisted at the centre in 1,991 instances and 1,49f home visits have been made. We are currently open seven days a week 9 am - 5 pm. with. a sister on call five nights. The Committee is seeking a sister who could do two days with nights on call rather than 9 am - 5 pm and would be glad to hear from anyone who could do this. A comprehensive report was given by Hon. Treasurer Mr. Max Cockerell, some interesting figures being Local support \$4,238, Lions Club \$1,460, Total assets \$61,320. A detailed audited statement is available. The President expressed the committee's appreciation for the work done by Mr. Cockerell, not only for his expert handling of finances but for his work in supervising the building programme, in itself a mammoth task. Following the reports, an election tock place for the three positions created by the expiration of three years service on the committee. All three retiring members, Cr. J. Haycraft, Mr. Lou Ackerman and Mr. Brian Oliver accepted nomination for re-election and Mr Barry Brenton was also nominated. The positions were filled by Cr.J. Haycraft, Mr.L.Ackerman & Mr. B.
