

VALE "TINY"

Elwin James Hoffman was born in the was: 1898 on the 10th of June at Macquarie Plains, Tasmania. This was the setting of his child and adult life as he was learning the arts of bushcraft and taking part in sporting activities. Both these areas of interest stayed with him throughout his 81 years plus on this earth.

"Tiny", 6'3" and averaging 14 stone, became a "Mainlander" in 1924 when he settled in Warburton as a timber getter. Tiny played football for East Warburton(now Wesburn) and was a keen cricketer. His love of "h'angling" taused him to spend much time in the Yarra and its tributaries and he also earned a reutation as a deadly shot with fire arms. Joseph and boy sand

So, as has already been qouted; "The only time Tiny was in the D.T.'s was when he was re-living some of his'Duck & Trout' adventures"

During his time at Warburton, Tiny was to fight and survive the 1926 bushfires and with an interim of 13 years narrowly escape the disastrous '39 holocaust at Anderson's No. 1 mill to where he had moved in 1933.

During the 40's Tiny married Molly Sund and purchased a residence in Lyell street. He continued his active life in the bush and mill for Cameron and Barton's Cumberland mill.

He is survived by his daughter, Patricia, who through this column wishes to thank every one in Marysville for their very kind help to her father in the past, including the staff and doctors at Eildon Hospital where Elwin spent his last 5 months including celebrating his Bist birthday.

There are many things can be said but one is certain....Tiny always said what he thought and, after all, why not?
