RATES REDUCED BY \$700,000

SHIRE OF MURRINDINDI

The Commissioners announced today that the rates required to be collected from the community will be reduced by \$700,000 for the 1995/96 financial year. Under the pre-amalgamation structure \$4.7 million would have been required from the community to operate the Shire, but consolidation of council finances and the development of a new organisational structure have lowered the rating requirement to 4 million.

"Mist of the mountains"

This \$700,000 represented the first financial windfall for the public from the amalgamation process and it comprises savings of \$350,000 in salaries and associated on-costs and a further \$350,000 from economies of scale in service delivery. Further savings should also result as examination is carried out on other recurrent costs and economies of scale as capital projects are realised. The aim is to complete this review prior to the budget being finalised in June 1995.

In the post amalgamation period, that is during the course of the 1995/96 year, savings should also become available as a result of the implementation of compulsory competitive tendering (CCT). It is intended that these savings can be identified for inclusion in the 1996/97 budget. The Local Government Board made no predictions in the area of CCT savings and at this stage, while it is accurate to say savings will occur it is far too early to quantify them.

The entrance to the Flowerdale Hall will be improved in the near future to decrease the traffic risk associated with vehicles moving in and out from the Yea Whittlesea Road, Commissioner Carlson announced today.

"This issue has to be addressed to ensure the safety of the people leaving the facility, particularly the elderly. The works costing approximately \$3000 will commence shortly. A grant has been applied for by the Shire from the Department of Health and Community Services for the construction of entrance ramps and heating to the building.

The Murrindindi Shire is at present undertaking an asset survey of all public buildings to ascertain requirements for the future. Once the facts are gathered a policy will be determined as to the level of support that can be afforded to each facility. It is highly likely there will be a rationalisation of assets in this area. This will allow a greater benefit to be derived by the whole community from the limited funds available," Commissioner Carlson concluded.

REFLECTIONS ON HISTORY

FROM MARYSVILLE & DISTRICT HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Just musing while reading the costs of buying a home these times. Shockin', eh. I remember about 14 Wirreanda Festivals ago; a young local man put a lot of effort into his housing display on a tray body truck as a float in Wirreanda Street Parade. All the material in the exhibit was gathered in the bush where logging was taking place, at no monetary cost. Slim but strong sapling sticks formed the framework, lashed where necessary with narrow strips of narrow inner bark.

Morewide slabs of bark, fitting exactly, overlapping and anchored in place with more sticks and bark for tying formed the waterproof roof. Walls were a complete enclosure of vertical bark sections except for the doorway. Propped up parts allowed for window light. This was called a bark hut and I have seen one with earth floor where a man lived long ago.

When Maroondah Dam was being builtin the 1920s, there was a complete village for workmen which sprang up right on the site. Whole families were in residence in a tidy settlement of houses of whitewashed bags and canvas stretched a framework of various size poles. The occupants even grew flowers around the door. This plan would never be allowed now, thank goodness, but these people were there from 1920 till 1926, when the bushfires destroyed the village - which sported a general store and boarding house - and all their personal possessions. 200 men were engaged on this great project at Healesville - most lived in the town as it was a long walk to the schools.

Around 1927, when the tragic Pitman family was leaving "Kooringa" - their then guesthouse business, the need arose for the Misses Pitman to have a new residence. This resulted in the building of the Log Cabin.

Notice it there, in the centre of our town. Mr Percy Postlethwaite was the builder. Messmate logs cut from spas on Mt Kitchener were brought in and fitted in this picturesque design. Hand-adzed beams were cleverly installed after preparation in the bush and handcut shingles covered the roof.

The house is a wattle 'n' daub style, although no wattle is used The daub was made from earth dug near the creek and mixed with creek water. The hole was left for later when water from this handy creek was chanelled in to form a tiny lake. Above this lake a beautiful white blossom shrub was planted, making a perfect reflection on the water in spring.

All done with materials for homemaking in simple form. "Just naturally."
