Join the fun in Lions Park ... Commencing Saturday 26th January 2008




CEO Visiting Schedule

NOW OPEN!

The 'terracotta room' regional food & wine centre & cafe

There's been much anticipation about this new venture in Marysville's Village Walk.
Is it a café?

Is it a wine bar?
Is it a restaurant?

Well, we were all right! It is *all* of those things and more!

Chris and Barbara Muir set out to create a 'destination within Marysville'. A tasting centre for locally produced food and wines as many of our regional alpine wineries do not have their own cellar doors.

Barbara: We live in a wonderful food producing area and we wanted to combine the 3 elements of wine tasting - a deli for local cheeses, small goods and an eatery. We did not want to just concentrate on any one of those things. So often visitors ask at the Information Centre "Is there a vineyard here where we can do some tastings of local wines and have some food?"

Chris: This is a small town and maybe it could not support just another café. We thought that the opportunity to taste wines, try a variety of local produce, and to have a fine dining experience would be the way to go.

We invite people to walk in and browse without even feeling that they should buy. To take a look at our range of deli goods, daily fresh salads, cold meats, Milawa Cheeses, Milawa Mustards, Australian coffee, also our own warm roasted lightly spiced nuts to mention but a few. We have resourced our range of food so as to not overlap on the brands which are already available in Marysville.

We want to promote the town as a whole. The 'terracotta room' is to be a centre where visitors to the town can get a comprehensive experience of our regional foods. We do have the deli aspect so people will even be able to purchase take away salads and deli platters for picnics and for their B&B. We also want to make available to accommodation owners platters for guest arrivals.

Barbara: We will carry a variety of Australian teas and coffee. We have blind taste- tested these from Victoria to Cairns. We found that although most were Australian roasted they were still imported beans. We were looking for Australian grown beans – 100% Australian coffee – a quality coffee. We have found these and have settled for serving one variety in the café and having 2 available for retail.

As far as we can, everything we retail will be 100% Australian. In the food preparation we will sometimes be forced to occasionally use imported ingredients and with local produce we are looking to buy as 'close to home' as possible.

Chris: The 'terracotta room' will be all about informal fine food and wine where visitors and locals will find something to their liking. They might just want to drop in for simple fare such as a home made blueberry muffin and coffee or perhaps something like lemon roasted chicken and avocado on toasted focaccia. And the most important thing is that we are doing something we enjoy doing. It is what we both have a *passion* for. And having discovered Marysville – the place where we most definitely want to live – we really want to succeed.

We invite everyone to come in for a browse and feel free to take a look around without obligation to buy. Just come and have a look and see what we're doing.

TN: And before Marysville?

Barbara: Chris is Australian. He trained as a chef at the Intercontinental in Sydney, moved across to the U.S. but finally found his niche in the U.K.

We met 7 years ago at Portsmouth where I was opening a new visitors attraction centre and Chris took the catering franchise. Prior to that I had always followed my career in hospitality and tourism management and development. We married in 2005.

In 2004 we holidayed in Australia, first time here for me. Some time later, back in the U.K. we both realised that we were ready to move on as we had reached the pinnacle of what we were doing. We wanted to run something together and the idea of living in Australia appealed to me and Chris felt it was time to come home.

Chris: The first 'terracotta room' was in a vineyard in the U.K. where evidence of a Roman settlement had been found – and the Romans used terracotta pots to store their wine.

I did the U.K. restaurant up the same way as we are doing here and with Australian cuisine. I diversified by making my own range of Australian bush food chutneys which I was pleased to have featured at Fortnum and Mason in London. I will be making those same chutneys here. We'll let you know when.

Whilst there I also set up a wine importing business of Australian wines. Although some of the big brand vineyards had their wines in the U.K. the smaller ones could just not get a foothold. I took trips home to Australia to source boutique wineries and would represent them in the U.K.

TN: Nothing was left to chance in the setting up of this new venture. The overall appearance is one of quality and good taste. The made-to-order timber units and shelving by Narby Cabinets, the birch coloured tables and black comfy chairs carefully chosen.

NB: At the time of going to print the wine license had not come through but is expected within the next fortnight.

Both Angelique's Kitchen in Alexandra and the Yea Men's Kitchen have already been going strong for the last 12 months and will be soon restarting in 2008.


Despite the name, Community Kitchens are not soup kitchens or a cooking class. Participants pay for food and generally cook 1-2 meals for themselves and their families at each session. Most importantly, group members decide what they are going to cook. The majority of last year's members agree that the kitchens are more about getting together with other people than anything else. Statewide, Community Kitchens have also grown with over sixty kitchens up and running in Victoria.

Angelique's Kitchen will be restarting again in February, while the Men's Kitchen in Yea will be getting together again on Wednesday 13th February and both need new members to keep the fun and cooking going. Both are held every Wednesday morning.

Angelique's Kitchen is held at St. John's Parish Hall and has been set up for mums, with on-site children's activities provided on cooking days to make it that little easier for mums to get out with others. Mums usually spend the session talking and cooking and end up with a few meals to take home and enjoy with the family.

MAYOR'S CHAIR

Council hopes you and your families had a safe and happy festive season. This is the first week of the Councillor media articles. As in the past each week Councillors will rotate with an article for the papers and a radio presentation on UGFM Tuesday morning at 8.15 am. The Mayors Chair will also be provided each week covering general issues across the shire with a radio presentation on UGFM every Wednesday at around 8.15 am.

Council has been advised there will be 7 Councillors elected in 7 Wards within the shire at the November 2008 Council Elections. Once the maps that identify the areas more clearly are provided we will display them for the community.

Last year council took part in the first stage of the Transport Legislation Stakeholder Engagement process. Across Victoria there were 1200 individuals and organisations who took part in the process with the government receiving 61 submissions. We look forward to seeing the first part of the report which will be released sometime this year as we are all aware of the problems within the shire of suitable public transport.

Council has accepted an extension of the Community Building Initiative program funding for the Kinglake Ranges. The program will now be fully funded until the 30 September 2010. This program is working extremely well and we hope it will eventually spread across the shire.

There were a number of storms early in the month which left many areas of the shire with quite a bit of damage. The Acheron caravan park was badly hit with parts of Flowerdale and Kinglake being left with trees uprooted and debris. Residents and council have been very busy cleaning up the area's with work still needing to be done. Outdoor staff are doing their best to remove the debris. If you have an area which you believe may have not been reported then please fill out a works request form at one of the shire offices or contact the shire and have it filled out over the phone. These forms can be used

for requesting any work residents believe needs to be attended to by the shire.

With the heat and dry conditions it always pays to be prepared for the possibility of a bushfire. There were several small fires in the Thornton, Eildon and Taggerty which were quickly attended to thanks to the emergency services. The bushfire season can be stressful for some people and help is available for you. For clarification of fire prevention activities and responsibilities, you can contact the Fire Prevention Officer at Council on (03) 5772 0333. The Victorian Bushfire Information Line can also assist you and can be contacted on 1800 240 667.

If you have any stressful situation not just in bushfire season you can call the health services numbers within our shire, Alexandra Community Health on (03) 5772 0800 and Mitchell Community Health (incorporating Yea and district) on (03) 5784 5555, or Lifeline for assistance on 131 114. If you know of anyone who may be suffering from stress please pass on these numbers so they can get the help they need.

Our young people will be back to school before we know it with a number of our little ones starting school for the first time. We wish our students and teachers all the best for the new school year, one which will be packed full of learning experiences for everyone.

It was great to hear about the Water Week Awards with a number of winners from our shire. We congratulate our young people from Yea, Eildon, Buxton and Kinglake for their work and commitment and for providing great ideas on saving water. The School Patch Competition quote was 'Save Water, It's the fabric of Life'.
