Narbethong - Moving On

TN called on a few of the businesses around Narbethong to see how they are getting on, five months on from February 7.

The Black Spur Inn: They harboured, nurtured and fed hundreds of Black Saturday fire refugees over a period of many weeks. And then they invited the rest of us, from the extended Triangle area, for free meals and a place to gather together to share our experiences and counsel one another.

Di, Jim, Scott and James have been living here for just 3 years but are such a solid part of our community. Now that they are able to get down to 'business as normal' again, we asked them to share with us their vision for The Black Spur Inn in the immediate future.

Scott: *It was 3 years ago on June 26th that we got the keys to the Inn. July 17 was the first night that we opened the bar. We did it in 26 days! The rest of the refurbishment followed in stages, a continual work in progress. We are still growing the business and adding onto our first business plan. We intend building a nice beer garden in the gardens with a bandstand so we can present entertainers and cater for larger crowds on those beautiful Triangle days.*

We want to make the Black Spur Inn a must stop destination rather than a drive through. A high quality venue to stop for a drink, cup of coffee, a snack, a meal or stay in one of our lovely furnished accommodation rooms. We wish to look after locals as much as possible with a nice atmosphere of cosy log fires in the winter, beer garden in the summer and good food all year round in the air conditioned restaurant.

We have a good cross section of wines from the Yarra Valley and Upper Goulburn Valley vineyards as well as other areas. Some of our featured local wines are Challen Little River from Taggerty, Rubicon, Snobs Creek from Eildon, Kinloch and Delatite from Mansfield. We source locally grown organic vegetables and produce wherever possible and to guarantee consistency of quality we now hang our

own meat. We also try to employ staff from the local area so when you come in you will be greeted by a familiar and welcoming face. We currently are being well supported by our locals and contactors and are looking forward to increased tourism and to visitors coming back to see the regrowth and rebuilding in our great region.

Mystic Mountains Ski Hire - Rosemary Sisson tells us of her enthusiasm for the area and her positive outlook on the current situation:

There is tremendous opportunity right now for local businesses. Then there is a whole new population that have to be accommodated, fed, clothed and entertained. Those are the clean-up workers, the government workers, and other recovery personnel. And there are so few businesses to cater for them. Is it any wonder that the businesses that are operating have never had it so good?

The situation isn't going to change in the short term either. The clean-up workers will soon be replaced by builders and tradesmen. Glaring opportunities exist for accommodation, food, hardware businesses. I now do swap-a-gas and may well get an ice making machine in the spring.

The people who had businesses need commercial leases so as to be able to get up and going again.

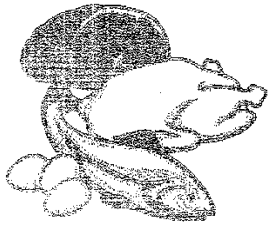

Councillor Comment

Road maintenance

Road maintenance is always of importance to residents and as winter highlights the potholes, I thought some background information would be helpful.

Road authorities, including councils, were forced to be more accountable for the maintenance of public roads following a High Court ruling in 2001.

A public road does not include every government road; but rather roads (or sections) which are deemed, by the Council, to be required for general public use.

The *Road Management Act 2004* requires the Council to keep a register of public roads. For these roads various minimum standards have been determined by Council through its *Road Management Plan (RMP)*.

All public roads within the shire receive regular inspections depending on their classification. For example a major link road is inspected every six weeks whereas an access road is inspected every six months.

It is important that Council is able to respond to defects (eg: potholes) within the time frame set out in the plan 100% (or as close to this as possible) of the time.

On an unsealed rural access road, potholes greater than 75mm in depth and covering over 20% of a 1km length are required to be repaired within six months. In practice the Council aims to achieve a better response rate, however this time frame is considered reasonable for the available budget and the extent of the road network.

The Council's road maintenance and operations budget is approximately \$2mil of which \$730k is spent on the maintenance of 670km of unsealed roads or on average \$1,100 per km of road per year.

Approximately \$500/km is utilised on grading, \$250/km on potholing and another \$250/km on light applications of gravel / crushed rock.

It should be noted that these maintenance allocations are prioritised according to need based on inspections of the network, and not all roads will require grading maintenance every year.

The Council's RMP can be viewed on Council's website www.murrindindi.vic.gov.au and maintenance queries or works requests can be directed to the Council's officers on 5772 0333. Alternatively works requests can also be completed on-line via Council's website.

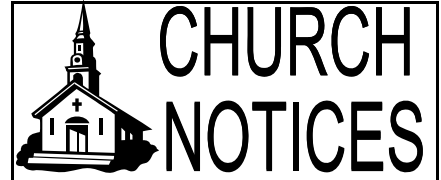
Building green towns

Congratulations to the Flowerdale/Hazeldene community for hosting Bob Dixon, Mayor of Greensburg, Kansas, to speak to on Sunday 28 June.

Mayor Dixon oversaw the green rebuilding of Greensburg, after it was destroyed by a tornado. The commitment to rebuilding a sustainable town has been hailed as a 'world first' and revitalised and renewed both the township and its people. This city's rebuilding efforts include utilising 100 percent wind power and implementing a resolution that all government buildings are built to LEED platinum specifications, including Greensburg's city hall, a school, and a county hospital. Eight hundred residents and 60 businesses have since committed to incorporating sustainable design practices into Greensburg's 'Green town' rebuilding efforts.

A total of 356 sales have occurred through (Solarshop Australia & NEGHA) the "**Pure Local Energy**" community bulk buy solar project after the rebate ceased three weeks early on 9 June for the Solar Homes and Communities Program SHCP (\$8000 rebate).

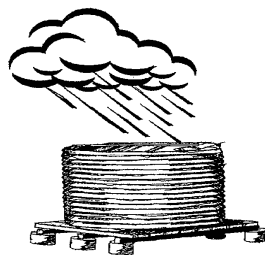

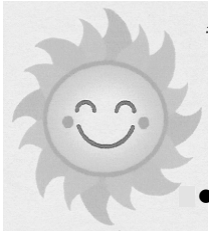

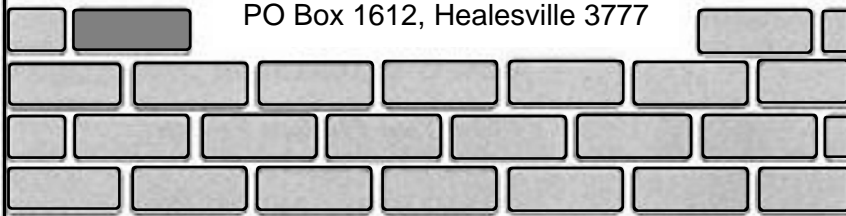
