Steavenson Falls weekend shuttle bus commences

The New Name is Marysville Central!

DSE in conjunction with the Steavenson Falls Reserve Committee of Management are pleased to announce a shuttle bus service to Steavenson Falls Scenic Reserve on weekends and public holidays. Repair and restoration works since the fires of February 7 have progressed and it is possible to walk the main pathway to a viewing area near the base of the 84 metre waterfall.

Falls Road and the Steavenson Falls car park still require significant repair work to make them suitable for large vehicle numbers, therefore public access will only be offered via a free shuttle bus service run from Gallipoli Park sports ground. The shuttle bus will take visitors to the car park from where it is an easy 15 – 20 minute return walk to the viewing area near the base of the falls.

Please note the shuttle service will only operate under suitable weather conditions and therefore may be postponed on short notice.

Commencing on Saturday December 12th 2009. The shuttle bus will operate every Saturday

and Sunday (excluding Boxing Day) and also on New Years Day and Australia Day, continuing until med February 2010 when the reserve will be closed for road resurfacing and car park repair works. The shuttle bus will provide a 45 minute round trip from Marysville with departures on the hour every hour between 10:00am – 3:00pm. The service will run on a first come-first served basis.

Local residents who wish to revisit Steavenson Falls or were not able to make the visit in August are advised to arrive for the 10:00 am departures as tourist numbers are expected to increase throughout the day. DSE staff will be in attendance on December 12th to provide information and collect feedback.

All other walking tracks in the reserve remain closed and mid week access is not possible due to ongoing works and heavy machinery operation.
