Waterfalls and walks open around Marysville

Many waterfalls and walks close to Marysville are now open for visitors to enjoy.

This unique area of the Yarra Ranges National Park was severely damaged by the February 2009 bushfires. With the help of volunteers, licensed tour operators and the hard work of Parks Victoria staff, most sites are now safe for visitors to return to and enjoy.

Popular visitor sites are found along Lady Talbot Drive on the outskirts of Marysville. These include Phantom Falls, Keppel Falls Walk and The Beeches Rainforest Walk and picnic area.

The viewing platforms at Phantom Falls and Keppel Falls offer views of waterfalls cascading over enormous granite boulders in a landscape recovering from bushfire. Walking tracks to the falls have been repaired and upgraded since the fires, providing a safer visitor experience and access to the falls.

"Before the fires the views of the falls from the platforms were interrupted with tree ferns, lush gullies and towering gum trees. Since the fires the views have definitely changed for the short term. Nature has provided a unique view of the falls and also an opportunity to see this area of the park recovering close up," commented Ranger In Charge Mark Krause.

More waterfalls and walks can be found at Cambarville Historic Area, which is only a short drive from Marysville, along the Marysville-Woods Point Rd. Cambarville Historic Area boasts Cumberland Walk, which takes in The Big Tree, Sitka Spruce, Sovereign View and Cumberland Falls. Further along the Cumberland Walk you will find Cora Lynn Falls and on returning to Marysville a stop at The Big Culvert is a must.

"People are returning to the Marysville area and wanting to visit many areas in the park which is great to see. With the recent rainfall the water is roaring over the several waterfalls in the area", said Mark.

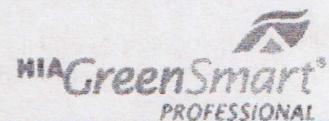
