Pool party to rock Alexandra

The Alexandra swimming pool is set to party this Friday night (18 February), with local DJ music, amusements and of course swimming to keep people entertained.

The party is being hosted by the Alexandra FReeZA committee and plans to bring a range of youth together.

Second year committee member Ayden Embling said Friday night's event was a new FReeZA initiative in Alexandra.

"Our focus is delivering an event for primary school age kids between 5pm-7pm, followed by the Alexandra Secondary College age group from 7pm-10pm," Ayden said.

Supported by Murrindindi Shire Council's FReeZA worker Bob Cummings, the committee has been meeting weekly to plan and deliver music and cultural events throughout the year.

Carly Purcell, also a second year committee member added: "We look forward to a big turn out at this year's first event, and hope that other young people are inspired to join the committee."

The Marysville Triangle Twilight Bus service will be running for young people to access Alexandra for the event. The bus has two suitable departure times from Narbethong at 6pm and 7.30pm travelling via Marysville Bakery and Village, Buxton and Taggerty V/line Stops before arriving at the

Alexandra V/line stop at 6.30pm and 8pm respectively.

A free bus service will be available departing the swimming pool to return young people via Taggerty to the Marysville Triangle communities. The bus will depart at 10pm. For further information on bus transport contact Stuart Collier on 5772 0712.

Council's Community and Customer Service portfolio spokesman Cr Cris Ruhr encouraged young people to support the event.

"Come along and support this terrific youth initiative, tickets are available at the door for \$5 per person," he said.
