RESIDENTS of Marysville, Narbethong, Granton, Buxton, Taggerty and the wider Triangle region celebrated the reopening of the Cumberland Resort swimming pool and day spa as the Marysville YMCA on Sunday.

Highlights of Sunday's Community Open Day included activities focused on family participation with a jumping castle, Sumo Suits, Aqua Aerobics, a sausage sizzle and YMCA Victoria CEO Peter Burns said it was a great day.

The YMCA Marysville features a 20 metre pool, steam room and will offer lap swimming, Aqua Aerobics, Aquatic education and schools programs.

## FUNDS TO RE-ESTABLISH CARAVAN PARK

A STATE Government grant of \$300,000 to Murrindindi Shire Council will help cement confidence that 'business is back' in Marysville, the Member for Seymour, Ben Hardman, said.

Mr Hardman said the grant to the council for the Marysville Caravan Park Re-Establishment Project would reinstate fire-damaged assets at Marysville Caravan Park, provide stimulus to the tourism industry and cement confidence that business is back in Marysville.

"Marysville is slowly rebuilding, businesses will gradually return and the nature it is famous for is recovering," he said.

"In order to continue that process and prepare for the return of visitors, the town needs to be ready and able to accommodate visitors with a range of accommodation options.

"The State Government is taking action to fund practical projects that help fire-affected communities get back on their feet."

Mr Hardman said the project to reinstate fire damaged assets includes:

- redeveloping and upgrading the existing caravan park area as year-round serviceable park to Crown Land caravan park best practice;
- upgrading existing Crown Land assets at the park to meet the needs of the tourist camper;
- sensitive design and planning for the extended area of Crown Land reserve to the north west as a seasonal park; and
- developing a public access trail network along the Steavenson River in a sensitive environmentally and culturally managed public river reserve.

Regional and Rural Development Minister Jacinta Allan said the Victorian Government grant was provided through the *Small Towns Development Fund*, which was helping Victoria's smaller towns create jobs, drive economic growth and improve community infrastructure.

"So far, the fund has provided more than \$54.7 million toward 510 community and social infrastructure projects worth more than \$112 million right across provincial Victoria," Ms Allan said.
