Have Your Say on the Rail Trail Management Plan

During their July council meetings, Mitchell, Murrindindi and Mansfield Shire Councils all adopted the Goulburn River High Country Rail Trail (GRHCRT) draft Management Plan for the purposes of public exhibition and comment.

The GRHCRT draft Management Plan provides guidelines for the management of the Rail Trail to help facilitate a safe and enjoyable user experience as well as the protection and enhancement of environmental assets and ensure consistent management of the trail through the three municipalities.

The plan addresses a comprehensive range of topics which will enable the Rail Trail to be managed and promoted consistently across the three Shires including:

Governance

Environment and cultural heritage

Assets maintenance

Emergency management

Risks

Tourism and marketing

After the consultation period closes and submissions considered the plan will be updated before final approval is sought from each Council. The Rail Trail is on track for completion by December 2011.

Council cleans up with new skid steer

Murrindindi Shire Council's latest plant acquisition will allow a multitude of works to be carried out by the one machine.

The skid steer is a small rigid frame machine that allows a wide variety of labor-saving tools or attachments to be utilised for a range of activities from excavating to street sweeping.

Council's Assets and Infrastructure portfolio spokesman Cr. Chris Healy said the skid steer would be utilised across the shire.

"It certainly gives our outdoor teams and parks and gardens staff a greater array of options when it comes to maintenance, repairs and

new works," Cr Healy said.

"The skid steer will be used for small scale excavation works, site clean ups after construction projects through to sweeping gravel off intersections and roadways.

"We have already seen a great benefit by removing wet leaves from paths that usually make the surface slippery, thus improving safety for pedestrians.

"The skid steer will be put to great use."

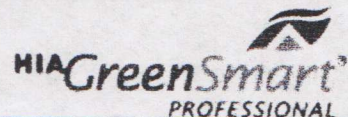
