Council staff on hand to assist at rebuilding days

Rebuilding days to be held at Marysville and Kinglake will assist residents in fire affected areas to gain one on one building and planning advice from Murrindindi Shire Council staff.

Mayor Peter Beales said the Rebuilding Days to be held in Marysville on Saturday 15 October and Kinglake on 22 October would provide a range of services for residents.

"One of the important messages that we want to get across on the day is that the Building Permit Reimbursement Program for septic tanks, dwellings and outbuildings will cease in December," Cr Beales said.

"This means that Council will no longer be able to waive fees associated with building and septic tank permits.

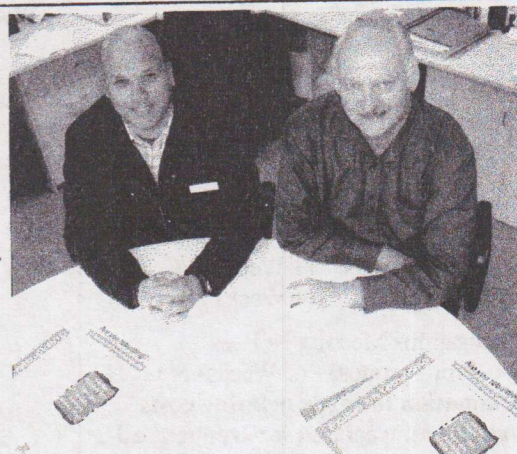
"I would encourage those people in fire-affected areas who have yet to make a decision on rebuilding their homes or were planning to install outbuildings to attend one of the two days."

The days will allow people to gain one on one help with planning consents and permits, support for building and planning matters, septic tank applications and assistance with site plans among other things.

The building days will be held at both the Marysville and Kinglake Rebuilding Advisory Centres from 10am until 2pm.
