## Cr John Walsh elected Murrindindi Shire Council Mayor

Koriella Ward Councillor John Walsh was tonight elected Mayor of Murrindindi Shire Council for the next 12 months.

He will be joined by Eildon Ward Councillor Chris Healy as Deputy Mayor.

Cr Walsh said his appointment was a great honour and he would continue building on the work of the Council and that of former Mayor Peter Beales.

"Tonight I would like to reflect on the positives. I would like to say that the Councillors, CEO and all the staff, on balance, have been doing a fantastic job," Cr Walsh said.

"We need to move ahead over the next 12 months from a recovery phase to building a solid foundation for this Council to continue to serve its community.



"I consider it a privilege to serve as the Mayor of Murrindindi Shire Council." Cr Walsh said there were many

challenges over the next 12 months and he would serve on a platform of keeping the community informed.

"It is important that the decisions and the issues we are grappling with are communicated to our community and those who can provide assistance such as the State Government
