## Lights! Camera! Action! for Alexandra and Thornton

Alexandra and Thornton have provided the backdrop for the filming of a period western called The Frontier.

Frontier productions Pty Ltd along with an entourage of more than 200 cast and crew have called the region home over the past month whilst they filmed scenes for the pilot episode of the series for America's NBC.

The pilot chronicles the journey of a group of disparate travellers from Missouri to the West Coast in 1840. As they struggle to survive, these strangers will be forced to band together and form a family, while they boldly press forward into the great unknown that is the Frontier.

Murrindindi Shire Council's Tourism and Economic Development portfolio spokesperson Peter Beales said that having a film crew in the area has caused quite a stir amongst the community, and has got tongues wagging.

"It's been great for the towns to have this influx of people. Almost all the available accommodation in Alexandra, Thornton, Acheron and Eildon has been booked out and the cast and crew have been keen to get out and explore our beautiful surroundings.

Over recent years, Council's Economic Development Department has worked with Film Victoria to

develop and maintain an image library on Film Victoria's "northeast" website that attracted interest from the producers. Following initial contact with the films location manager, David Hart, Council officers have assisted the production company with finding appropriate properties for them to set up their administration, costume and prop bases as well as identifying potential filming locations and local people with skills and knowledge to assist.

We have seen the pilot as a great opportunity to showcase our area and it has proven to be a significant economic boost to the

region with an estimated \$6 million state wide being spent," Cr Beales said. We will continue to maintain and add to the image library that was the catalyst for this exciting project and hope to see more of this kind of production in our region in the future.

Filming on the Goulburn River at Thornton is set to wrap up during April.

## Mayor's Chair

The past week has been one of advocacy on behalf of the Shire across a wide range of issues.

The AGM of Timber Towns Victoria re-affirmed the resolve of Rural Councils with a timber industry for the reinstatement of special funding to cover the impact of logging trucks on their rural roads. Up until last year such additional funding was made available by the State Government but now timber industry impacted roads are to be covered under the Country Roads and Bridges funding which has been allocated to all Rural Councils.

The Board of Tourism Victoria visited Marysville and the Triangle last week and I had the opportunity to discuss potential Shire-wide tourism support projects with the Board. The ideas were well received and a range of possible solutions and offers of assistance were made.

I also attended a meeting of the Central Ranges Local Learning and Employment Network (CRLLEN), a group doing excellent work in bringing industries and educators together to encourage greater school retention rates and increased youth participation in trade and tertiary training. The CRLLEN have insti-

gated the development of trade training centres in the region to increase opportunities for our young people and have been providing important assistance to the Murrindindi Training Institute.

Councillors and the CEO met with Rob Mitchell, the Federal Member for McEwen and the Hume Regional Committee of Regional Development Australia. Discussions covered transport, road infrastructure, communications, higher education and workforce participation. It was accepted that regional development plans should not only look at the major transport corridors but also take into account the issues confronting the smaller Councils along the Great Divide.

I thank Rob Mitchell for his support over the past three years in getting an early rollout of the National Broadband Network in the Shire. We may have only achieved early installation in Kinglake West but it is a start. We will continue to lobby for the broader use of high speed wireless services throughout the shire to replace satellite and dial-up.

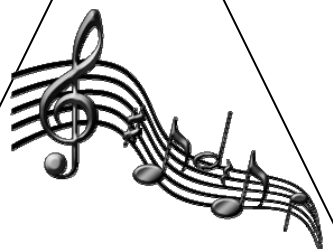

## Narbethong History Group 9<sup>th</sup> April 2012

New Years Eve 2010, on the banks of Fishers Creek with others ladies, I wondering what I could do to help Fire Affected Narbethong residents to recover from the tragedy. Narbethong was damaged most severely in the 2009 Black Saturday Fires with businesses, houses and lives lost.

I sat with Dianne Kennedy, a most remarkable lady who owns of the Black Spur Inn. Dianne and Jim her husband and sons, sheltered and fed 150 people for many weeks after the fires, in their hotel. Dianne asked me how she could get more history on the Black spur Inn and I answered that perhaps I could do that, thinking It wouldn't take more than a few phone calls and we could knock something up. As you can gather I'm a girl who thinks "the glass is half full" and with the help of a few friends" we can do it".

I phoned a few school mates who were surprised to say the least as we hadn't talked for easily 50 years and what transpired amazed me. I sent out a questionnaire to about 60 people and received stories of long ago but never before told. Some people believe they have enough material to write their own book. People from far away have contributed some wonderful information, in fact some read like a blockbuster movie.

And so a committee of enthusiastic people was formed. The members of the committee are mostly past resident of Narbethong. At least 3 members have never lived in Narbethong but want to help. Only two members are current residents. It would be good to have more local members.

We have received a number of stories about the far past but have little about the last 50 years. ## Councillor Comment

At the recent Services Review meetings, questions were raised as to what council is doing to encourage not only visitors but also new residents and investors to Murrindindi Shire.

Council has been part of a regional collaboration for over 5 years to deliver on the *Live, Work and Invest in Provincial Victoria* message. This has involved Mansfield, Mitchell, Strathbogies, Benalla and Murrindindi Shires under the Goulburn River and Ranges banner. The collaboration comes together at [www.victoriantreechange.com.au](http://www.victoriantreechange.com.au) where Murrindindi is promoted for its strategic location just 1½ hours scenic drive from Melbourne, with direct access to markets and to the full range of city services via the Maroondah, Melba and Goulburn Valley Highways and the Hume Freeway. With a supportive and progressive Council – we are focused on sustainable development opportunities and are strongly committed to encouraging business investment across the shire.

This year the State Government has committed a funding allocation of \$20,000 per non metro Council for the purposes of preparing for and delivering this message at the Regional Living Expo at the Melbourne Convention and Exhibition Centre on April 27 – 29 inclusive.

Council's Economic Development and Tourism officers have reviewed, updated and reprinted its lifestyle and investment brochures, compiled a series of outstanding regional images and a slide show and will staff the Murrindindi stand at the Expo. The intent is to interact with visitors to the Expo to encourage them to investigate the option of relocating to or investing in Murrindindi in the future.

Current residents are also encouraged to attend the Expo to enjoy the range of stands and the entertainment on offer including Marysville and the Triangle's very own steel pan band "Pans on Fire", who will be performing.

On tourism, a Visitor Research Study is currently being conducted which is focusing on visitation and visitor satisfaction to our region with a focus on Marysville and Eildon. The study 'Visitor Profile and Satisfaction Program (VPS)' is being supported by the Murrindindi Shire Council Tourism Unit in conjunction with Anita Donnelly, the Tourism & Events Manager for Marysville & Surrounds working with Yarra Ranges Regional Marketing.

The study, developed and delivered by Tourism Research Australia is aimed at establishing a demographic and behavioral profile of visitors to the region as well as measuring satisfaction levels and expectations. The study has been co funded by Council and Tourism Research Australia with financial support from the Marysville and Surrounds Marketing and Events funding provided by Tourism Victoria.

Interviewers located themselves in the high traffic volume locations of Marysville and Eildon over the Easter long weekend and will do the same on the weekend of 21 & 22 April. Visitors are being surveyed on their visit to the shire and asked to report on their experiences.

A final report is expected in July and will be made available to tourism industry stakeholders and any other interested parties and will be available for download from Council's website.
