Lions aid speeds up the quest for a cure

The worldwide search to find a cure for spinal cord injury will move a little quicker following the handover of \$150,000 by Lions International President Wing-Kun Tam.

In presenting a cheque to researchers at Melbourne's St Vincent's Hospital, President Tam said he was proud Lions could make such a significant contribution.

"The opportunity to make this donation is the opportunity to create miracles," he said. "This research is beneficial to millions of people."

The donation has enable St Vincent's to purchase a state-of-the-art digital virtual microscope, which will dramatically reduce the time researches spend analyzing slides.

"It will save us hundreds of hours of valuable research time," St Vincent's researcher Dr Kathy Traianedes said. "The microscope automatically takes sequential images of the slides. We used to spend two hors setting up each slide, now it takes about 20 seconds."

Dr Traianedes and colleague Dr Stephen Livesey, pictured above with President Tam, from the Department of Clinical Neurosciences are currently working on a cure for



chronic spinal injury by testing whether biological grafts can be successfully used to repair the spinal cord.

The grafts are used as a scaffold on which the spinal cord can regenerate itself and the results so far have been promising.

"We are seeing some movement, especially in our longer-term animal models," Dr Traianedes said.

The donation was made possible through the Lions Spinal Cord Fellowship, a fellowship which Marysville and District Lions Club has been supporting for some years. The fellowship was established to support research being conducted by StepAhead Australia, which is the major collaborator in Dr Traianedes' research.

The Gippsland-based research organisation was founded by Barbara and George Owen after their son Sam suffered a diving accident, breaking his neck in 1995. Their aim is to find a cure for spinal cord injury.

Mr Owen, an orthopaedic surgeon at Latrobe Regional Hospital in Traralgon,

said the donation is a big step toward finding a cure and turning the research into reality.

"One day our grandchildren will look back and be aghast that there was once a time when a spinally-injured person was told that medicine had nothing to offer them," he said.

Lions clubs from all over Australia donated \$75,000 and Lions Clubs International Foundation matched this funding through their Standard Grant process to reach the total of \$150,000.

Continued success in Dr Traianedes' experiments over the next two years is expected to lead into human clinical trials.

Mayor's Chair

Don't believe everything you read in some press releases. I made that mistake in relation to the National Broadband Network (NBN) roll out. The press release only listed Kinglake West as I commented upon last week. But since checking the detailed maps, the Shire has done a bit better with Kinglake and Pheasant Creek also in the initial NBN three year program.

Your submissions on the Shire's Services Review are being consolidated for Council's consideration in preparing this year's budget and its long term financial plan. Many issues have been raised but it is clear that the option of a rate increase greater than 6% has again been rejected confirming the position expressed last year when we first highlighted the financial challenges we are facing. The majority of comments relate to changes in the proposed cuts or efficiency improvements.

While the work is still continuing, I thank the CEO, Executive Management Team and staff for the way in which they have taken on the Council's directive to review Council's operations. It is clearly the most comprehensive review that has ever been undertaken for this Shire and I

am sure it will result in a more efficient, responsive organisation.

Council has also received the initial report on Rating Strategy options. The work was instigated in response to inequities in the share of rates being paid by different groups within the Shire. In offering a range of options considered to be appropriate for Murrindindi, the report highlighted the need to allow time for the community to understand the implications of each option. Given the current emphasis on the Service Review and the requirement to have a 2012-13 Budget prepared for public comment in the coming month, further work on changing the rates structure will be deferred until after the budget process when there will be time for community consultation. Any changes subsequently agreed on would be applicable to the 2013-14 Budget.

Bushfire Volunteer Group Announces Closure

Yarra Valley Practitioners Project (YVPP), the volunteer group set up to work with bushfire-- affected people of the 2009 Victorian bushfires, has announced that it is closing on Friday 11th May.

YVPP offers clinical services in counselling, hypnotherapy, kinesiology, massage, relaxation techniques, yoga and other complementary health services in Yarra Glen, Healesville and Marysville.

YVPP was given \$450,000 in funding in December 2010, shortly after the Baillieu Government took office.

YVPP is awaiting the result of an application to the Victorian State Government for further funding to enable it to continue:

If YVPP's bid is unsuccessful, Friday 11th May will be its last day of clinical services.

YVPP has also worked in Yarra Glen, Chum Creek, Badger Creek, Buxton, Toolangi, Kinglake Middle and Dixon's Creek Primary schools, engaging children with support programs to help with their recovery.

"It is with great reluctance that we make this announcement," said YVPP Founder and President Karen Dickson.

"We are proud that, over the past three years, we have enabled more than 170 wonderful volunteers to see hundreds of clients, and those clients consistently tell us how much this service has helped them and their families in their recovery.

We know that recovery for many people is far from complete. Our work is unfinished, but because we have been unable to secure funding to continue, YVPP reluctantly has to announce closure."

"We thank our wonderful practitioners, volunteers and staff who have made this project possible," said YVPP General Manager Ray Siegersma.

"YVPP acknowledges and thanks the State Government for their funding, without which the Yarra Valley Practitioners Project could not have continued into 2011/2012. We are grateful to those who generously granted us funds to enable us to launch the project back in 2009 – particularly Rotary International, the Besen Family Trust, Bendigo Bank Enterprise Foundation, Helen McPherson Smith Trust and the Eastern Ranges GP Association.

We've had so much support from so many sources.

"We sincerely thank the people and communities affected by the 2009 fires, to allow us the honour to be able to help them in their recovery, and for the amazing support they have given to YVPP," Mr Siegersma concluded.

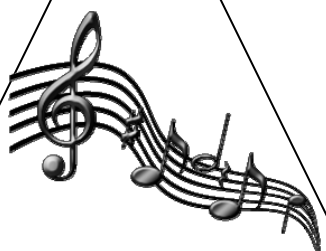
