Did you lose your home in the fires?

Did you find anything in the rubble that you have kept—any objects that were transformed by the fire?

I am a local artist making a short film documenting the relics we found in our homes in the Triangle area- as a starting point for our stories about the change in our lives as a result of the fires.

The film features the objects some of us found and have kept from the rubble of our homes after the bush-fires. Mementos are objects that honour or reflect an important life event. In this film I am paying homage to these relics or mementos, these simple, often strange objects that do not mean much to anyone else but the one who has kept them. In doing so, the film will pay respect to the profound changes that the bush-fires made in our lives.

It will use these transformed objects as a starting point for stories rising from the time after the fires.

If you have some objects you'd like to show me and would like to talk about them and your experiences, I would love to hear from you. If you have objects to show but do not want to share your stories, that is fine too.

Mayor's Chair

Preliminary planning makes for successful projects

The budget is out for comment and we have had some of the community meetings. Thank you to those who have attended and provided their insights and opinions. Councillors will take the feedback on board when refining and approving the final version.

As I have mentioned at the meetings, the Service Review is the start of a constant process of on-going self assessment to ensure we improve standards and get best value for money.

But it isn't just up to Council. As recently highlighted, a lot of Council projects are the result of community groups undertaking a lot of preliminary planning and then applying for funding which is allocated by State and Commonwealth Departments through Council. The results of the project often become the responsibility of Council to operate, maintain and replace.

From experience of the recent new assets we have learned to take into account the long term issues right from the start of the project. Community Groups with good ideas need to develop rigorous viable

Business Cases before we will agree to funding requests. Council will help in developing the Cases. Where this hasn't happened or where the projects are financially unacceptable, Council will not support the proposals.

It will sometimes mean that we will be portrayed as being anti progress. But we will wear that because we believe we will achieve more by having successful projects that stand on their own, rather than pursue a series of aspirational developments that may one day bear fruit but will always require rate payer support.

The roofing of the Yea Saleyards is an example of a project worth pursuing while the Kinglake Ranges Cultural and Community Facility is one where despite best efforts of all involved, a viable long term proposal could not be raised. In the latter case, Council will continue to work to achieve a facility for Arts Groups in Kinglake Ranges that can be developed within the available funds.

Celebrate new track opening at Cathedral Ranges

People and Parks Foundation and Parks Victoria are inviting the community to celebrate the opening of the a new walking track at the Cathedral Range State Park on Sunday 3 June, marking another significant step in the recovery of the park from the Black Saturday Fires.

As part of the celebration, People and Parks Foundation Project Officer Amanda Daw and Parks Victoria Ranger Rhyl Shaw will lead guests on an inaugural 4km walk along the new track.

The community event will recognise the role of local contractors, groups and individuals from the Marysville community and surrounds who have rallied together to build the track, funded by the Victorian Bushfire Appeals Fund over the past few months.

Support has come from local schools, community groups, volunteers, businesses and tour operators including Rubicon Outdoor Education Centre and Woori Yallock Farm School who brought in eager students from Ballarat and Healesville Secondary Colleges to help with constructing the track.

"It has been great to see everyone get passionately involved in this project," Ms Daw.

"We encourage all to join us with family and friends to celebrate the completion of this community project and discover some of the beautiful Messmate stands of forest that characterise the walk."

The new track will fill a missing link in the track network at Cathedral Range State Park – it connects the Sugarloaf Saddle visitor area with the Cooks Mill Heritage Site and camping area.

It is one of several Green Connections initiatives led by the People and Parks Foundation to engage the community in hands-on fire rehabilitation projects and connect with nature to improve health and wellbeing.

The easy, down-hill walk is suitable for all fitness levels. The celebrations and walk will start at the Sugarloaf Saddle visitor area. A shuttle bus will take guests back to visitor area for a light lunch.

Councillor Comment

It's been pleasing to see that despite the cold, community members have taken the opportunity to come along to our information sessions about the Draft Budget 2012/13.

These sessions are important as it gives those in attendance a chance to get an overview of Council's budget process and also allows them to raise concerns and questions and have them answered by either Councillors or other members of Council staff. The last remaining session is scheduled for Wednesday 23 May at 7.30pm at the Kinglake Senior Citizens rooms at the Kinglake Community Centre.

Are you wondering how to get rid of all the old chemicals you have lying around the home? We are encouraging all residents to take advantage of the 'Detox your Home' program which is coming to the Yea Saleyards on Saturday 16 June. This free service allows you to safely dispose of old cleaning products, paint, dead batteries and even weed killer stored around the home without putting a strain on the environment.

On the day, simply bring along your containers for disposal between 1.30pm – 4.30pm and you won't even need to leave your car. There will be instructions and directional signage at the site. Bring as few or as many products as you like but please ensure that the containers are no more than 20 litres or 20 kilograms.

Finally I wish to congratulate the North East Regional Development Scheme (NERDS) for winning the Regional Collaborations Small Council Award at the National Awards for Local Government. These awards recognise some of the innovative ways that councils are approaching the issues facing local government. It encourages them to work together and share good practice to improve their capacity to find unique local solutions for common problems.

NERDS is a regional training initiative made up of a collaboration of 11 regional council's including Murrindindi Shire Council and one Water Authority in the North East Region. NERDS works to get better value for money by combining resources to improve learning and development opportunities for staff, including on-line learning. In February this year NERDS won a Victorian local government award for new initiatives. Having now won the Regional Collaborations Small Council award NERDS are now in the running to win the overall National Award for Excellence.

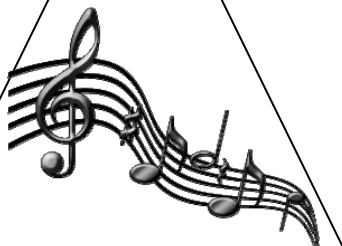

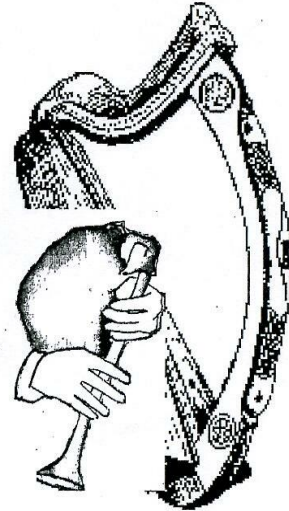
