## MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR PROGRAM SUPPORTS CFA VOLUNTEERS

CFA volunteers will be better equipped to protect their communities thanks to a share in a record \$11.95 million allocated under the new Volunteer Emergency Services Equipment Program (VESEP).

Deputy Premier of Victoria and Minister for Police and Emergency Services, Peter Ryan, today announced the emergency service groups successful in receiving the grants at an official event at the CFA Sale Fire Station.

VESEP is a new equipment grants program for local emergency services volunteer groups. The program aims to enhance the capability and safety for local volunteers when responding to emergencies, and provide the state with assets to continue to respond to the increase in significant events such as bushfires, floods and heatwaves.

As part of the 2012-13 VESEP, a record 166 brigades have received funding towards operational equipment and appliances such as quick-fill trucks, tankers, trailers and amenities upgrades.

Of the 166 grants, 34 are for equipment, 75 for volunteer amenities improvements and 57 for the upgrade or replacement of vehicles (see attached list).

CFA Chief Officer, Euan Ferguson, said the funding would provide a real boost to brigades across the state.

"In addition to these project grants, VESEP also allocated CFA \$1.4 million to a state-wide initiative that focuses on improving member safety and welfare, including new or replacement equipment such as pumps, generators and fire blankets," Mr Ferguson said.

"This initiative will provide valuable support to more than 60,000 CFA members who work tirelessly and selflessly to protect our Victorian communities."

Equipment grants have also been allocated to the Victoria State Emergency Service, Life Saving Victoria, Australian Volunteer Coast Guard, Shepparton Search and Rescue Squad, Volunteer Marine Rescue, St John Ambulance, Ambulance Victoria Community Emergency Response Teams and Citizens Radio Emergency Service Teams.

The Victorian Government VESEP initiative has been designed in consultation with volunteer groups, including Volunteer Fire Brigades Victoria. It was launched in February 2011 and will continue annually.

### Murrindindi Shire Council Community Grants



Council advises that due to the upcoming Council Elections a change has been made to the assessment period for the next round of Community Grants.

Applications, usually accepted from June to September and assessed in October, need to be submitted by 31 August with assessment in September.

The next application period will run from October to February for assessment in March.

## Visioning Day sets sights on the future

Community members across the Murrindindi Shire have started the process of developing a future vision for the region.

The Murrindindi Shire Council Community Visioning Day had more than 30 participants come together in Yea to discuss, debate and develop goals and aspirations they would like to see explored as the shire heads towards 2030.

Mayor John Walsh said the day was the start of a longer process in developing a vision.

"We had a good cross section of the community, and broad representation from across the shire. By exploring a range of themes and community-based aspirations Council will now look to further develop the outcomes of Sunday's workshop.

The themes discussed were:

- Physical and Transport
- Lifestyle and Leisure
- Cultural and Social
- Environment
- Townships/ Communities
- Local Economy and Jobs

"The day was designed for the community. We thank those members who had the conversation and presented their ideas on how we can improve as a Council.

"What was clear from the day is people love the lifestyle our shire offers, but believe we have real potential to grow our main population bases and look to develop opportunities in our agricultural and tourism section.

"It was also evident that health and wellbeing of our people are priorities."

The findings of Sunday's workshop will be collated with a report presented back to the Visioning Day members before it is developed further for comment.

For those unable to make the workshop, a shire-wide mail out is taking place to gain the views of the community on how they see their town, and how they would like to see their locality and shire progress towards 2030.

"The day was a success and we will build on the input of our community to develop a longer term vision for Murrindindi Shire," Cr Walsh said. "The findings will be important as future Councils develop their four year plans for the shire."

## Mayor's Chair

One of the challenges of Council, being that we are located so close to the edge of Melbourne, is determining how peri urban growth will impact on shires such as Murrindindi.

Our Council has been working closely with the Municipal Association of Victoria and a number of other Councils impacted by a growing Melbourne.

These peri urban meetings are the platform to express our views on the challenges faced by small Councils as the urban fringe expands.

In many cases the challenges are not new. Transport, the impact of growth, housing, service provision and environmental impacts all need to be considered. We are working to get the best outcomes so that the appeal of living in a shire such as Murrindindi and escaping the hustle and bustle of the city is not diminished.

With the peri urban councils coming together we hope to achieve better planning outcomes for our areas.

In a separate exercise Council has reviewed its guidelines for development within rural living zones and it is a good opportunity for the com-

munity to make comment on the proposed changes.

The guidelines are used to assess subdivisions and development applications on Rural Living zoned land.

The main changes proposed under the review include:

- Inclusion of bushfire considerations and standards to meet new state planning and CFA policy and requirements.
- Streamlining land capability assessment requirements for effluent disposal.
- Clarifying the type or extent of environmental works required in rural living subdivisions, with removal of any requirement for these works on lots proposed for dwellings.

General simplifying and updating of the guidelines.

The amended guidelines can be accessed by visiting the [Public Comment](#) page of Council's website and submissions will be accepted until 6 September.

We welcome the community's comment.

## New Shelter at Yea Cemetery

An exciting new development is nearing completion at the Yea Lawn Cemetery.

Kerry Tull, Secretary of the Yea Cemetery Trust, has been the instigator and driving force behind the project.

The Cemetery shelter will give visitors a quiet place to reflect in the shade or out of inclement weather and has been designed by former well known Yea resident Joanne Crawley. Jo is now a qualified practicing architect but designed the shelter while still in training,

The successful grant application to the Melbourne Water Pipeline Funding for \$87,000 was also undertaken by Kerry and included an extension to the watering system at the Lawn Cemetery.

Many in the community who have been watching the construction have queried whether the new building is a Chapel; and although it is only designed as a shelter, there is no reason why it could not be used for grave-side services.

Murrindindi Shire Council is trustee for the Yea Cemetery Trust and Cr Sally Abbott Smith as representative of the trustee said the stunning new building further enhanced other recent improvements completed at the Yea Lawn Cemetery including kerb and channeling of the roadways.

The roses and spring bulbs along the front fence which give an attractive welcome during spring and summer have been planted and are maintained by the Yea Garden Club and future plantings will include more shade trees to further beautify the area.

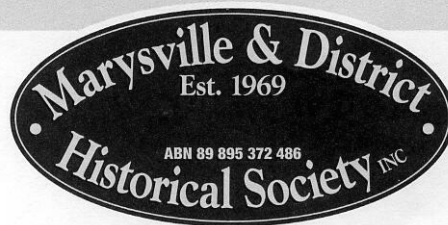

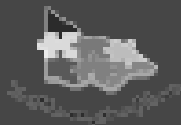
