The Baden-Powell Challenge Award

is the highest award a Guide can achieve. To start the Baden-Powell Challenge you need to have:

- made your Promise
- gained at least two Guide Challenge Badges
- gained at least two interest badges.

This shows your commitment to guiding.

The Baden-Powell Challenge is divided into five zones, each containing lots of different clauses. You need to complete ten clauses in total. You should do one from each zone, then five more. These can come from any of the zones. Up to two of them can relate to Country/Region or Girlguiding UK initiatives.

To finish the Award you need to take part in a Baden-Powell Adventure.

These are usually residential events organised by your County or Country/Region for all Guides in the area who are doing the Baden-Powell Challenge.

Zone 1: Healthy lifestyles

Aim: To encourage Guides to lead a healthy lifestyle by promoting physical, emotional and spiritual well-being.

Zone 2: Global awareness

Aim: To increase awareness of global issues and of the contribution each Guide can make.

Zone 3: Discovery

Aim: To challenge Guides with new experiences and adventure.

Zone 4: Skills and Relationships

Aim: To develop Guides' self-confidence and self-worth and to improve their interpersonal and life skills.

Zone 5: Celebrating diversity

Aim: To promote active citizenship among Guides, developing their awareness of rights and responsibilities for all.

Community grant assessment changes

Murrindindi Shire Council's community grants scheme funding applications have been brought forward so as not to clash with the Local Government elections in October.

It means the applications usually accepted from June to September and reviewed in October, will need to be submitted by 31 August with assessment taking place in early September.

Council's Community and Customer Services portfolio spokesman Cr Cris Ruhr said the grants were designed to assist locally based groups and organisations and were primarily for once-off or start-up projects or activities aimed at growing an event.

"We do hold three rounds each year, so while the assessment has been brought forward on this occasion we will continue with our normal scheduling following the elections," Cr Ruhr said.

Application guidelines are available on Council's website www.murrindindi.vic.gov.au but generally amounts up to \$500 do not require matching contribution, however amounts between \$500 to \$5000 require matching cash or in-kind.

Applications may be submitted in more than one round and will be decided on merit, taking into consideration Council's mission, values, objectives and strategies.

Community encouraged to comment on proposed planning zones

Murrindindi Shire Council is preparing a response to proposed changes to the state's planning zones that would see nine existing zones deleted, five new zones created and the amendment of 12 existing zones within rural, commercial, industrial and residential areas.

Council's Planning and Environmental Portfolio spokesman Cr Bob Flowers said the state government changes represent a major overhaul of the Victorian planning system.

"As a Council we are working our way through the changes, but I also encourage shire residents to take an interest in the proposal which is currently on public exhibition," Cr Flowers said.

"While it is a state government run consultation period, it is important that our residents are aware of the proposal and be across the positives and negatives of such proposals."

Cr Flowers said the matter would be up for discussion at the 27 August meeting of Council.

"Council's planning department is currently assessing the proposal and we expect a comprehensive report to be presented at the end of the month. While there is a desire to simplify some aspects of the planning requirements, we are also mindful of the impact they may have on our communities," Cr Flowers said.

The Department of Planning and Community Development is seeking comments, with the report available at <http://www.dpcd.vic.gov.au>, under the Planning tab on the homepage. It will remain on exhibition until 21 September.

Mayor's Chair

Many thanks to all those who took part in the Vision 2030 Workshop. The discussions were lively and lots of ideas produced on the way the Shire should be in the future. It was also great to see people from different communities working together to discuss Shire-wide issues and later to raise points for their particular locality.

I am not going to list the proposals because I don't want to risk influencing your thoughts about the way in which the Shire should develop. We have sent out letters asking for your opinions. Don't feel constrained to limit the number and range of your ideas to fit the size of the brochure or the listed categories. Send in all your proposals.

All the ideas will be collated and an initial report developed for comment. I expect the report will act as a catalyst for more ideas and discussion. Clearly not all the good ideas can be undertaken at once. The next Council through its four year Council Plan will develop a logical priority list and start the first batch of work.

The collaboration demonstrated during the Vision 2030 Workshop is

going to be more essential than in the past. For the Shire to progress we need to be successful in pursuing State and Federal grant funding. With major projects, Governments are looking to support partnerships covering more than one locality or community group. We will only achieve success through having a clear long term plan (Vision 2030 will be the basis) which is supported across the Shire. Future grant applications must be linked to the progressive implementation of the long term plan. Because of this I encourage you to contribute to the development of Vision 2030 and be part of its evolution so we can present solid Shire-wide evidence of the need and support for Shire projects.

Community Local Law

Living in a community carries with it certain responsibilities for all. Many of these responsibilities are outlined in our Local Laws. Council is currently reviewing these laws to make them easier to access and follow and more efficient to administer by the Council.

The purpose of the proposed 'Community Local Law' is to provide:

Peace, order and good government of the shire

A safe and healthy environment so that the community can enjoy a quality of life that meets its expectations

The safe and fair use and enjoyment of public places

The protection and enhancement of the amenity and environment of the shire

A fair and reasonable use and enjoyment of private land; and

A uniform and fair administration of the Local Law.

The format of the proposed Local Law has been restructured and simplified into the following parts:

Safety of people and property
Environment
Streets and roads
Administration
Enforcement

Municipal Fire Management Plan

This revised plan provides a new structure and risk based approach to fire preparation, prevention, response and recovery in the shire. This approach to fire planning is common across the Hume Region and all of Victoria and demonstrates Council's commitment to the safety of our communities.

The community will be asked for comment in September and October before the plan is presented to the new council for adoption.
