Amnesty period on open air burning in residential areas within Murrindindi Shire

The summer fire season is approaching and property owners are advised to prepare their properties against the threat of fire. Every landowner has a responsibility to themselves and their neighbours to ensure they take the necessary steps to prevent fires and reduce the risk of injury or damage to persons or property.

Working in conjunction with the CFA and the Municipal Fire Prevention Committee, Council will allow an '**AMNESTY PERIOD**' for burning off in residential areas, in preparation for the fire season.

During this amnesty period, residents/landowners will be allowed to 'burn off' any vegetation material on their properties without requiring a permit from **29 September to 15 October 2012**.

Residents burning off need to ensure that smoke from their fires do not cause a nuisance to neighboring properties.

No windrows are permitted to be lit and all fires must be no larger than one metre in diameter or one metre in height.

The local fire brigades have been made aware of this 'amnesty period'.

For persons not wishing to burn off, Council is offering residents **free disposal** of their household vegetation material at all Waste Transfer Station sites from 29 September until 15 October 2012. Residents are reminded that they are required to present their Tip ID Tag or current rates notice to site attendants to be eligible to dispose of green waste free of charge.

The free disposal offer does not apply to commercial operators.

Residents wanting to use a commercial contractor to dispose of their green waste must make prior arrangements with Council's Coordinator Waste Management to utilise the free service provisions.

Amnesty supports fire prevention efforts



Murrindindi Shire Council is supporting residents and landholders in residential areas in their efforts to be fire ready, by putting in place a burning off amnesty period and providing free green waste disposal at all Resource Recovery Centres (Transfer Stations).

From Friday 29 September until Monday 15 October residents and landholders will be able to burn vegetation materials in residential areas without a permit.

Council's General Manager Sustainability Michael Chesworth said there were conditions to the amnesty including keeping fires to a metre in diameter and height.

"It is important people do not create a nuisance to their neighbours when burning off. This is not about creating bonfires and the like, it is about a sensible approach to cleaning up land and have it in a condition that could limit the impacts should a bushfire occur," Mr Chesworth said.

"People need to control the size of their fires and ensure there is minimal smoke. It is about working together to ensure that we clean up, but have minimal impacts on neighbours."

Mr Chesworth said an alternative to burning was using the free green waste disposal of vegetation at any of the shire's Transfer Stations.

People wanting to use the green waste service will need to present their tip ID tag or provide a current rates notice to prove eligibility to the site attendants.

"The free offer does not apply to commercial clearing and maintenance operators," Mr Chesworth said.

Inquiries regarding the amnesty can be directed to Council's Local Laws unit on 0408 576 712 or 5772 0376.

"By working together and taking responsibility we can go a long way in reducing fire hazards before the start of summer," Mr Chesworth said.
